Now, 21 of the 36 offshore wind farms in Taiwan are in Changhua County, and Changhua County is producing 63 percent of Taiwan's total wind power.

In the future, there are plans to build even more wind turbines in Changhua County. These wind farms will provide enough energy for millions of people in Taiwan every year! Changhua County is lucky to have so much wind. Let's help Taiwan have cleaner air and brighter skies!
